


Cara's Nursery Rhymes

So, they all took a hot bun and boy were they good!





Oh no, do you think we did something wrong?


Just then, a woman came to the window and said:

OK, great, we're sorry!



Cara: "By the light of the moon!"







They all walked for a while then it began to get dark. They could see the moon coming up and said they would


